3-Year Crime Statistics

Reporting Year 2024

Gannon University has compiled statistical information on specific crimes and calculated the Crime Rate for those incidents reported to the Campus Police & Safety Office. The below includes the previous three calendar years. This information is being provided to all students and employees as required by State and Federal regulations. The criteria used to compile statistics for this report, the Annual Security Report and the 60-Day crime Log, is different for each one; so numbers will vary from categories in each. Questions regarding the information should be directed to the Campus Police & Safety Office.

The Pennsylvania College and University Security Act requires the release of crime statistics and rates to students and employees, and it requires that those statistics be available to applicants and new employees upon request. The rate is based on the actual number of Full Time Equivalent (FTE) students and employees, which is calculated according to the state-mandated formula. The crime rates were calculated by multiplying the number of recorded crimes by 100,000 to obtain the population base, and then dividing that number by the full-time equivalent (FTE) population of students and employees. The first number before the slash is the number of incidents reported and the number after the slash is the crime rate.
